

Community Paramedic PROGRAM

Using the North Central EMS Curriculum, this program will provide all required content for the Community Paramedic including:

- Core content specific to the Role of the Community Paramedic
- Content specific to Community and Public Health
- Cultural Competency Community Assessment
- Chronic Disease Assessment, Teaching and Management

The program will begin with one **required** face-to-face on-campus session (**Friday May 19, 9-12 pm**) for orientation and introduction to the online learning format. Over the next three months, participants will work through online modules at their own speed, submitting learning assessments at the completion of each module. All modules must be completed successfully prior to the return to campus (**120 hours**).

Participants will then return to campus August 14-18, 2017. This week will include hands-on learning in physical exam skills, use of home health equipment, wound care, PICC lines and ports, and suturing. Participants will also gain exposure to community resources, perinatal care, psych-mental health simulation and model patient experiences (**40 hours**).

Clinical experiences (40 hours) may then be completed in Milwaukee (placement fee applies) or in your home community using established criteria (must be arranged by paramedic/paramedic's home department). It is expected that clinicals will be completed by November 1, 2017. Participants will receive a certificate of completion after all three units (online content, face to face learning and clinical experiences) have been completed. For those able to attend, we will have a graduation ceremony on campus Friday morning, **November 3, 2017.**

It is recommended that the paramedic considering this program have a minimum of two years of experience, be comfortable with computers and be available to come to Milwaukee on May 19 and the week of August 14-18, 2017.

Course fee: \$2,250/paramedic
Clinical placement fee \$250/participant
